


**\*WARNING!\* DO NOT LOOK DIRECTLY AT THE SUN WITHOUT SPECIAL ECLIPSE GLASSES!**

**A solar eclipse happens when the moon passes between the Sun and Earth.**

*As the Moon blocks the Sun's light, it casts a shadow on part of the Earth. When the Moon blocks all of the Sun's light, it is a total eclipse.*

**Here in Columbus:**

- The partial eclipse starts: **1:55 p.m.**
- Time of totality: **3:11 p.m.**
- Duration of totality: **Roughly 2 minutes**
- The partial eclipse ends: **4:28 p.m.**
