

FREE PARENT SURROGATE VOLUNTEER TRAINING!!



When: Tuesday December 4th, 2018 9am-1pm

Where: Columbus City Schools (CCS) 737 E. Hudson Street Columbus, Ohio 43211.

What: CCS is looking for individuals to be parent surrogates for students who have or may have a disability. A parent surrogate is an individual who is trained by the state to represent a student at an IEP or ETR meeting due to the student being in foster care or in the custody of Franklin County Children Services. Essentially the parent surrogate attends any special education meetings, signs off on special education forms, and ensures that the student is receiving appropriate services.

More Info: The training will familiarize a person with special education law, IEP requirements, and Ohio operating standards. Time commitment for volunteering is minimal and all surrogates are called in advance to confirm their availability.
