

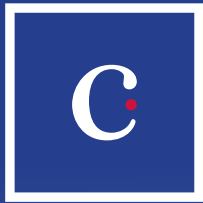

Audition Requirements:

- Solo piece
- Sight-reading
- Scales:
Strings: 2 octave major scales: D, G, B \flat
Woodwind and brass: 2 octave major scales: B \flat , F, G
Percussion: demonstrate proficiency on snare drum, timpani and/or xylophone including rudiments on snare drum;
3 octave scale on xylophone: G, F

No audition fee or tuition fee. Students must make their own transportation arrangements. Student participants will receive a certificate of participation. Special funding has been secured for this Columbus Symphony project.
