- Solo piece
- Sight-reading
- Scales:

Strings: 2 octave major scales: D, G, Bb

Woodwind and brass: 2 octave major scales: Bb, F, G

Percussion: demonstrate proficiency on snare drum, timpani and/or xylophone including rudiments on snare drum; 3 octave scale on xylophone: G, F
