If the board approves the recommendations, it would bring to 12 the number of schools slated for auction and the number of schools being retained for future

use as schools by the district to

Sixty-two schools have been closed since June 1972 and 16 of them have either been sold or are in the process of being sold. The remaining 24 schools, including Central, are either being leased, used in some other district capacity or sitting idle.

Although the report made no proposal about what to do with Central, Hyre previously has said it could be retained for some kind of educational use if it isn't sold.

However, he has said the school board is not close to making a decision about what to do

with the prime, 16.7-acre Central site Downtown.
