

PREPARING FOR PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES

• School conferences will be held on <u>Jan 23rd and Feb 4th from 3:45-7:00pm</u>. Please choose the date that best suits your schedule. You will receive information from your child's teacher with details on scheduling time.

The goal of these conferences is to let you know how your child is doing at school, what they are learning and the plan for teaching them this year. It's also a time for you to give feedback and ask questions of the teacher

How to Prepare Before Conference

Look over schoolwork

Talk with your child about any questions/concerns they may have Make a list of questions

At the Conference

Be on time and prepared

Ask the most important question first

Give teachers positive feedback- what is working

Possible Questions to Ask

(PICK THE TOP 3)

How will my student be evaluated?

What are my child's strongest and weakest subjects?

What are some examples my child's strengths and weaknesses?

Does my child turn homework in on time?

What can I do at home to help support my child's academic progress?

What types of tests & evaluations will my child have to take this year?

How are my child's test-taking skills?

Is my child participating in class discussions and activities?

How are my child's social skills at school?

Does my child seem engaged?

Have you noticed any unusual behaviors?

Has my child missed any classes other than excused absences?

Do you think my child is reaching his or her potential?

After the Conference

Update your child

Make a plan with your child

Follow up with teacher and/or other support staff

Continue to stay in touch with the teacher/support staff

Update your contact information via parent portal



Attention 2nd Grade Families

Columbus Public Health Dental Sealant Team is returning to Winterset this year! This is a free service that will help prevent cavities on your child. Dental decay is the number one unmet health care need in children and this is a wonderful opportunity to get this work done for free.

The team will be at Winterset on January 15, 2025 to place sealants on second grade students who return a consent form. Consent forms will be sent home with students in the next few weeks. The team will also check 3rd grade students who received sealants during the 23-24 school year.

Types of School Choice Applications:

School Choice Lottery: For parents/guardians of KG-12th grade students wishing to apply to attend a school other than the school assigned.

Reservation Admissions: For students who currently attend a school that is eligible to reserve a seat in the next school with the same programming. Reservation applications will be available on January 6, 2025 and must be submitted by January 31, 2025 via the School Choice link in the Infinite Campus Parent Portal.

Request to Return to Home School: For students attending a school in Columbus City Schools that is not their school of address. The request will be available for submission beginning on January 6, 2025 and must be submitted via the School Choice link in the Infinite Campus Parent Portal by March 21, 2025.

Selective Admissions: For students who meet specific criteria. The Selective Admissions application will be available on January 8, 2025, for students who qualify, and must be submitted via the School Choice link in the Infinite Campus Parent Portal by January 31, 2025.

Inter-District Open (IOE) Enrollment: For students living outside of the Columbus City Schools boundaries and wish to attend a school in the CCS District. IOE application deadlines follow the same deadlines as the School Choice Lottery.

School Choice Dates to apply for the 2025-2026 School Year:

- Elementary School Lottery Applications: On-time lottery applications accepted via the <u>Parent</u>
 <u>Portal</u> for the lottery draw Monday, February 3, 2025 through Monday, March 31, 2025. Late
 applications are added to the bottom of the waitlist in the date/time order of receipt.
- Selective Admissions Applications: Applications available to eligible students Wednesday,
 January 8, 2025 with a submission deadline of Friday, January 31, 2025. Applications must
 be submitted via the Parent Portal.
- Request to Return to Homeschool Application: Accepted via the Parent Portal Monday,
 January 6, 2025, through Friday, March 21, 2025.



HOW TO ACTIVATE THE PARENT PORTAL

Each parent/guardian has their own_personalized Activation Code.

- 1. Go to our website at www.ccsoh.us and click on the Students and Families Families tab.
- 2. Click on the **PARENT PORTAL box** at the bottom of the page.
- 3. Click on the button that says **NEW USER ACTIVATION**.
- 4. Enter your **ACTIVATION CODE** (contact your school to obtain one if needed). We know it's long that helps keep the data secure so type carefully. Once the code has been activated, it can't be used again.
- 5. Follow the prompts to set up your username/password and to add a recovery email address.

FORGOT USERNAME/PASSWORD

6. Click on **EXISTING USER** in the Portal, then click **FORGOT USERNAME/PASSWORD**, and the information will be sent to the email used to set up the account. If you no longer have access to the email you used when setting up the account, please send a picture ID and your student's name and date of birth to <u>parentportalaccess@columbus.k12.oh.us</u>.
