As part of the School Health Services of Columbus City Schools, and in fulfillment of Ohio Law 3313.69, school nurses conduct periodic **student health screenings**. The screenings include: vision, hearing, and dental. The school nurses perform the various screenings in pre-kindergarten, special needs pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th and 11th grades and students new to the school district.

Lynn Righetti.






## **LIBRARY**

## WINTERSET PBIS STATE RECOGNITION



### HOW TO ACTIVATE THE PARENT PORTAL

Each parent/guardian has their own personalized Activation Code.

- 1. Go to our website at www.ccsoh.us and click on the Students and Families Families tab.

- 3. Click on the button that says **NEW USER ACTIVATION**.
- 4. Enter your **ACTIVATION CODE** (contact your school to obtain one if needed). We know it's long that helps keep the data secure so type carefully. Once the code has been activated, it can't be used again.
- 5. Follow the prompts to set up your username/password and to add a recovery email address.

#### FORGOT USERNAME/PASSWORD

6. Click on **EXISTING USER** in the Portal, then click **FORGOT USERNAME/PASSWORD**, and the information will be sent to the email used to set up the account.
