SPECIALTY LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES/CURRICULUM:

Briggs High School offers an extensive college preparatory curriculum that includes sciences, language arts, honors English, math, world languages, social studies, business, technology, physical education, the arts, computer programming, and more. Our program includes Advanced Placement courses in several different areas as well as the opportunity to earn college credit concurrently with the College Credit Plus program. Briggs also offers two career-technical education pathways for students: business and construction. These pathways will enable Briggs students to fulfill graduation requirements and give them the chance to earn college credit and industry credentials. Briggs students are held to a high standard and learn in a safe and secure environment. They are provided a rigorous curriculum with a focus on blending modern technology with learning. Our learning community promotes continuous improvement through student ownership, engaging classrooms, and real world connections. Students at Briggs are recognized for academic excellence with awards and special event assemblies. Academic award letters are given to those who have achieved honor roll status during each of the four grading periods.
