WHAT MAKES THIS SCHOOL OUTSTANDING:

Ohio Avenue Elementary is a welcoming, student-centered school where families, staff, and community partners work together to support success. Students engage in a full academic program including reading, math, science, writing, and the arts. Support services include Special Education, Gifted & Talented, and ESL. Tools like iReady, and HMH help meet students where they are and push them to grow.

SPECIAL LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES/CURRICULUM:

Ohio Avenue Elementary is a Health Sciences Academy, integrating health, science, and social-emotional learning into daily instruction. In partnership with OSU's Wexner Medical Center, students build skills in self-awareness, decision-making, and wellness alongside core academics, ELA and math.

We provide strong academic and wellness support through a school improvement grants and community partnerships. Students benefit from tutoring, literacy interventions, gifted services, special education, and extended learning. On-site staff includes a nurse, counselor, social worker, and therapy services to support the whole child, each day.

FAMILY SUPPORT and RESOURCES:

At Ohio Avenue, families are part of the learning team. With support from our Family Ambassador and Partners Achieving Community Transformation, parents join monthly workshops on academics, social-emotional growth, and community resources. School events bring families together through fun, hands-on learning experiences that strengthen school-home connections.

COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS:

Ohio Avenue partners with more than a dozen organizations—including The Ohio State University, COSI, Nationwide Children's Hospital, and the Columbus Crew—to create a school environment where students are supported, challenged, and excited to learn. These partnerships bring tutoring, mental health services, real-world learning, and enrichment activities into the school day. Together, we make learning fun, meaningful, and connected to our community.
