Students wear red, white, and blue uniforms and follow routines that promote focus and pride in self, school, and community. Our curriculum includes all core subjects—reading, math, science, social studies, health, art, music, and physical education—and is aligned to Ohio's Learning Standards. With a focus on foundational skills and character development, Stewart prepares scholars to succeed in school and life.
