## From The Desk of Principal Peddle


Dear Devonshire Families:


I want to take a moment to express my sincere gratitude for your continued support as we wrap up the first quarter, and navigate into the second quarter. I am incredibly proud of our students, teachers, and staff for their hard work and the tremendous learning and growth happening in our community. We have seen some great growth from the end of last school year, to the beginning of this year, and we continue to see it into the second quarter.



Below, I outlined our data comparing grade level data from end of year (EOY) last school year (Left hand side), to beginning of year (BOY) this year (Right hand side). We see significant numbers of students who are ready for grade level instruction (green columns below), especially increasing from EOY to BOY.

Devonshire Elementary Diagnostic i-Ready Results SY23-24 EOY Results vs SY24-25 BOY Results







What an exciting time to be a Cheetah! Our students are ready to learn and show what they know! Below I outline four pieces of data...beginning with the 3rd Grade Reading Proficiency Over the Years. This chart shows the percentage of our third graders who have met or exceeded the 3rd Grade Reading Guarantee. While we saw a small dip in the 2021-22 school year, our overall trajectory continues to be going up (as indicated by the orange arrow). More specifically, we saw an astounding 15% increase in 3rd graders proficient in the OST/3GRG from SY 2022-23 to SY 2023-24.

Below that, I showcase three grade levels' OST results over the years. 3rd grade showcases their fall 2022 OST results compared to their spring 2023 OST results. This shows a great increase in the number of students who are proficient or above!

Our fourth grade (middle photo) students show their spring 2023 to spring 2024 OST results, and increases in proficiency. Additionally, our firth graders (far right photo) show a great increase in their proficiency since third grade, increasing the green, blue and purple as the graphs traverse left to right.




**3rd Grade OST Results**Last year's 3rd graders (this year's 4th graders) Ohio State


