Senior Semi-Formal Tickets and Attire

- Friday, May 21st from 7-9 pm at The Boathouse (formerly Confluence)
- Tickets for the Semi-Formal will be \$60 per person.
- We will be selling tickets beginning the week of Monday, May 10th during the Senior lunch period. Cash only please.
- Attire is dressed up, but not prom dress. All clothing must follow CCS dress code policy.





Senior Semi-Formal Requirements

- CCS Requirement students must have at least a 85% Credit Recovery course completion by May 21st to attend the Senior Semi-Formal
- All students who wish to attend the Senior Semi-Formal must attend school for at least $\frac{1}{2}$ of the school day on May $21^{\rm st}$
- Bring a note if you need to leave school early
- Students who come to the Senior Semi-Formal under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be permitted into the venue and a parent will be contacted immediately suspension will also occur, which can affect a student participating in graduation
- Due to Covid-19 protocols students and their guests will be assigned seats and will need to wear a mask in the venue (except when eating)



Senior Cookout

- Wednesday, May 26th from 11 am- 1pm
- Cost is \$10 to be paid in advance. Cash only starting the week of May 17th.
- No water balloons, water guns or other toys resembling a weapon will be permitted. Doing so could result in you not being able to participate in graduation.
- We will have games, music and other socially distanced activities! Students will still need to wear masks to participate.
- Students must be "On Track" to graduate in order to participate
- Any misconduct can result students being asked to leave (no refund) and/or unable to participate in graduation

Vancelism

• Students who participate in senior Pranks that cause damage to any Columbus City School Building or trespass onto another school property will not be able to participate in graduation

Senior Pranks

• Students who vandalize any building or property will be responsible for paying an outside agency to clean up or repair damages

Graduation Rehearsal

- Students who wish to participate in the Commencement Ceremony <u>must attend</u> the graduation rehearsal
- Students must wear masks and practice social distancing for the entire rehearsal
- Rehearsal begins at 9:00 am on June 3rd, 2021 in the MFHS gymnasium.
- CCS Transportation will be available to take students home at 11am, but students will need to find their own transportation to the building and get here on time.
- Students will need to follow all adult directions or they will be asked to leave. Not following directions could also result in your child being unable to participate in graduation.
- Students will be given their cap and gown at the end of rehearsal provided all fines fees and chromebook equipment have been returned/paid for



Graduation

- Greater Columbus Convention Center Union Station Ballroom
- June 5th at 5:30 pm
- Students must arrive at least one hour early (4:00 pm)
- Park only at the Vine Street Garage (37 Vine Street). Parking will be \$5
- 2 tickets per student. Names of 2 guests <u>must be provided</u> for COVID tracking purposes.
- Guests will be permitted into the venue (Vine Street entrance) 15 minutes prior to the start of graduation. Guests must wear a mask, remain seated the entire time and practice social distancing.
- Graduation will be live streamed on the CCS Facebook and YouTube channel for family members or friends who cannot attend.
- Stanchions will be set up afterwards to greet the graduates. Do not go into an area that is roped off. Everyone will be asked to leave the venue 15 minutes after the ceremony ends.



Graduation cont...

- Attire-Business casual; no tennis shoes, jeans, shorts, sunglasses or hats. The CCS Dress Code policy will be enforced.
- White gowns- Wear light colors, white, no loud or bold patterns
- Red gowns- Any color will be acceptable
- Students may not decorate their caps, gown or masks. If it is decorated, the student will be asked to remove the decorations or not participate in the ceremony. Masks also need to be in good taste and not distract from the ceremony. Additional masks will be provided at the venue.
- Students will not be able to carry purses, cell phones or other items during the ceremony. We are asking students to give these things to a trusted adult to hold onto until after the ceremony.
- Any misconduct during the ceremony will result in a hold on the students diploma
- Guests should also be prepared to follow mask and social distancing guidelines while inside the venue
