*Netiquette is your etiquette - which is a code of polite and appropriate behavior among the members of a group - on the Internet.

By signing this pledge, you are pledging to abide by the general accepted rules of network etiquette. These include (but are not limited to the following:

- I pledge to be polite. I will not write or send abusive messages to others.
- I pledge to use appropriate language. I will not swear, use vulgarities, or use any other inappropriate language.

- I pledge to refrain from use of unauthorized games, videos, movies, and other non-lesson technology while in the classroom.
- I pledge that I will not take pictures or videos of students, staff, or property of the school
 without explicit permission from my teacher. I also may not share digital work, pictures
 or videos of other students, either within the district or outside of it, without explicit
 permission from my teacher.

I understand that the use of technology in the classroom is a privilege intended to contribute to and enhance learning. Any behavior that disrupts the learning environment will be met with appropriate consequences.
