

## Credits Required for Renewing Ohio Credentials

To renew your teaching credentials in the state of Ohio, you must earn 6 semester hours, 9 quarter hours, 18 CEUs, or a combination of these credits after the **ISSUE DATE** of your expiring certificate/license and after the **APPROVAL DATE** of your IPDP.

The following chart explains the equivalents of semester hours, quarter hours and CEUs.

### CONVERTING SEMESTER & QUARTER HOURS TO CEUs

Semester Hours		Quarter Hours		CEUs
1	=	1.5	=	3
2	=	3	=	6
3	=	4.5	=	9
4	=	6	=	12
5	=	7.5	=	15
<b>6</b>	=	<b>9</b>	=	<b>18</b>

← The number of credits required to transition to or renew a license.

**1 semester hours is equivalent to 1.5 quarter hours or 3 CEUs.**

**Note: CEU credits can only be used to renew teaching credentials. They cannot be used to obtain an advanced degree, a continuing contract, or in other instances where college/university credit is required (such as salary increases).**
